GROW IN THE WORD

01. Jesus answered a lawyer's question and defined "neighbor" with a story about a man who was robbed, beaten, and left for dead on the side of the road. In the story, a priest and Levite both pass and avoid the man without offering aid. A Samaritan came upon him next, and offered him compassion, kindness, and extravagant care (v. 30-35).

- What stands out most to you in this parable?
- Why do you think Jesus chose a Samaritan to be the hero of this story?
See John 4:9; Luke 9:52-56.
- How would you describe the Samaritan man's treatment of the man in need?

02. Jesus concluded his parable by asking the lawyer which of the three men proved to be a neighbor to the man in need. The lawyer answered by describing the actions of the Samaritan man. Jesus exhorted his listeners to go and do likewise (v. 36-37).

- How would you define "neighbor" in light of this parable?

GROW IN THE WORD

- What are some social or cultural barriers that might prevent you from showing compassion or mercy to someone in need?
- What are practical ways you can follow Jesus' instruction and seek to imitate the good Samaritan? See James 2:14-17; 1 John 3:17-18.
