# NEHEMIAH

NEHEMIAH 2:1-8

PASTOR ROGER POUPART

After I arrived in Jerusalem and had been there three days, I got up at night and took a few men with me. I didn't tell anyone what my God had laid on my heart to do for Jerusalem. The only animal I took was the one I was riding. I went out at night through the Valley Gate toward the Serpent's Wall and the Dung Gate, and I inspected the walls of Jerusalem that had been broken down and its gates that had been destroyed by fire. I went on to the Fountain Gate and the King's Pool, but farther down it became too narrow for my animal to go through. So I went up at night by way of the valley and inspected the wall. Then heading back, I entered through the Valley Gate and returned. The officials did not know where I had gone or what I was doing, for I had not yet told the Jews, priests, nobles, officials, or the rest of those who would be doing the work.

So I said to them, "You see that we are in. Jerusalem lies in ruins, its gates have been burned. Let's rebuild Jerusalem's wall so we will no longer be a disgrace. I know how the gracious hand of our God has been on me, and I know what the king has said to me. They said, 'Let's start rebuilding,' and their hands were strengthened to do this good work. When Sanballat the Horonite, the Ammonite official, and the Arab heard about this, they mocked and despised us, asking, 'What is this you're doing? You're rebelling against the king?'" I gave them this reply, "The word of the heavens is the one who will give us success. We, his servants, are building, but you have no share in this building, for you have no share in the building or historic claim in Jerusalem."

even in times of distress



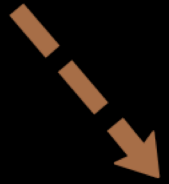

\*Centennial years are not leap years (-5)  
but every 400th year is a leap year (+1)
