- Clear instructions for the rotations in the Go-to-Guide for SBS that are easily understood and implemented.

Monday, June 14

Bible Point: God knows you.

Key Bible Verse: "O LORD, you have examined my heart and know everything about me." (Psalm 139:1)

Bible Story: God identifies David as the future king. (1 Samuel 139:1)

Prayer Requests:

- The children will understand that Jesus loves and knows everything about them.
- All aspects of the first day will run smoothly.
- All VBS/SBS leaders will take time each morning to meet with God in prayer and seek His guidance before the children gather.
- Everyone teaching and helping will be filled with joy and enthusiasm.
- God will protect the health and safety of all of the families and children participating.
- The technology will work well for the families participating in SBS.



Tuesday, June 15

Bible Point: God hears you.

Key Bible Verse: "I love the LORD because He hears my voice and my prayer for mercy." (Psalm 116:1)

Bible Story: David escapes Saul and writes psalms

to God. (1 Samuel 23:1-14; Psalm 86))

Prayer Requests:

- The children will understand that God hears and attends when they talk to Him in prayer, and answers in His timing.
- The Holy Spirit will lead in everything that is said and done, giving light, wisdom, flexibility, and joy.
- All who are leading and helping will be sensitive to the needs of each child.
- The music, words, and lessons during the Opening Assembly will be meaningful to the children.
- The Bible lessons will be easily understood each day so kids can apply God's Word to their lives.

• Craft time will run smoothly, and children will be excited about each craft.

• Children will have fun playing the games and show good sportsmanship.

• Snack time will run smoothly, and children will be appreciative.

Wednesday, June 16

Bible Point: God comforts you.


Key Bible Verse: "He comforts us in all our troubles so that we can comfort others." (2 Corinthians 1:4)

Bible Story: God reassures King Hezekah. (2 Kings 18:5–19:34)

Prayer Requests:

- The children will learn to turn to God for comfort and will give thought and attention to how they can comfort others with God's love.
- All of the stories, songs, activities, and snacks will help the children to learn and remember that they are treasured by God.
- God will give wisdom in presenting the Bible lessons and answering the children's questions.
- During KidVid, the children will see an amazing video each day about a real kid living out their faith. Pray that these videos will inspire children to trust Jesus in deeper ways.
- The children will be excited for the opportunity to raise money to provide VBS for children in India.





Thursday, June 17

Bible Point: God forgives you.

Key Bible Verse: "But you are a God of forgiveness, gracious and merciful,

slow to become angry, and rich in unfailing love." (Nehemiah 9:17)

Bible Story: Jesus reinstates Peter. (John 18:1–21:19)

Prayer Requests:

- The Gospel presentation during assembly will be powerful and easily understood.
- Children will learn that:
 - ♦ There is nothing that we can ever do to be good enough to go to heaven because we have all done wrong things that make God sad.
 - Jesus willingly came to earth to pay the penalty for our sins by dying on the cross.
 - When we trust Jesus as our Savior and confess our sins to Him, He forgives us for everything that we have done wrong; then He lives within us forever.
 - Once we have accepted Jesus as our Savior, He provides for us in amazing ways and helps us to grow to be more like Him.
 - ♦ Unbelieving children will trust Jesus to be their Savior.
- Believing children will grow in their faith and understanding that through Jesus' power, we will live forever.
- Children will discuss ways that they can share Jesus with other people they know.
- God will give wisdom and discernment to those counseling the children who make salvation decisions and to those who have questions. Raymond

Friday, June 18

Bible Point: God chooses you.

Key Bible Verse: "I have called you by name; you are mine." (Isaiah 43:1)

Bible Story: God chooses Esther to save her people. (Esther 2-8)

Prayer Requests:

• The Gospel presentation, counseling time and follow up will be used by God to draw children into a personal relationship with Jesus.

- Believing children will gain understanding about their relationship with God and experience a deeper connection with Him.
- Children will learn that once we have the love of Jesus in our hearts. He wants us to love others.
- Children will share what they have learned at VBS with others.
- Children will continue to grow in their relationship with God through worship, prayer, Bible reading and attending church.

- God will help these children remember the Bible verses and God's promises for life.

- New believers will have someone to help them to continue growing in the Lord.

- All who participated will sense God's pleasure with their work, and He will bless them.
- God will continue to use SBS throughout the summer in the lives of other children and families wherever He chooses.
