GROW IN THE WORD

01. Knowing that his betrayal was near, Jesus gathered his disciples for supper. During the meal, Jesus took on the role of a humble servant and prepared to wash his disciples' feet. Peter initially resisted Jesus, but Jesus explained that washing was required to have a place with him (v. 1-11).

- What stands out to you about this interchange between Peter and Jesus?
- What did Jesus believe about God and his circumstances that preceded this act of service? List the things John mentioned that Jesus knew.
- How does Jesus' act of humility inform and challenge how you serve others? See also Mark 10:42-45.

02. Jesus explained the importance of what he had just done and instructed his disciples to follow his example of humility and service. He promised to bless to those who did so and predicted his betrayal to buffet his disciples' faith as his journey to the cross neared (v. 12-20).

- How does Jesus' teaching about servanthood challenge modern ideas about leadership and greatness? See Mark 9:35; Matthew 23:11-12.

GROW IN THE WORD

- What are the barriers that might prevent you from adopting Jesus' mindset about leadership, service, and greatness?
- In what ways, can you follow Jesus' example of humble service in your relationships with others in your families, workplaces, and communities? Consider Philippians 2:3-4; Romans 12:10.
