 In what ways were you encouraged by last week's study?

• What are some things you care about most in life?

# **GROW IN THE WORD**

Paul informed the Philippians that though he was imprisoned, his circumstances actually resulted in progress for the gospel. He explained two gospel positive outcomes from his imprisonment (v. 12-14).

• How did Paul's imprisonment result in the two outcomes he described in verses 13 and 14? Put the outcomes in your own words and see also Acts 28:17-31.

• How did Paul's faith and devotion to Jesus shape his thoughts and actions while he was imprisoned? Take note of what you've read in Philippians 1 so far and Acts 28.

Two groups of people preached Christ with greater confidence and boldness as a result of Paul's imprisonment. One group preached with pure motives while the second group did it out of selfishness. In either case, Paul rejoiced (v. 15-18).

• What are the different motivations you see in these verses? Compare Bible translations to get a broader range of meanings.

• Why and how was Paul able to rejoice even when people preached Christ out of envy and ambition? Take note of 2 Timothy 2:8-13.

# **GROW IN THE WORD**

Paul rejoiced because the gospel was preached and because he expected deliverance from his imprisonment. Likewise, he expressed confidence that he would remain faithful to honor Jesus in life or in death (v. 19-21).
