

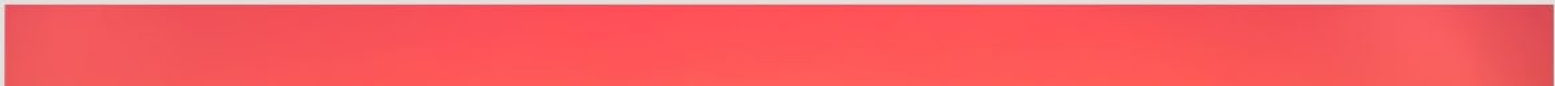

THE PSALMIST WAS IN A HOSTILE ENVIRONMENT – IN A “FORCED” EXILE

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4. Liars probably slandering about the psalmist (verse 11)

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- 5. Thinking about God during the night hours (vs. 6)**

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- 4. God is worth pursuing more than anything else in this world (vs. 8)**

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- When enemies and unfavorable people surround the psalmist, it's not his soldiers *like Joab* and military strategy that deliver him, but it is God who delivers him (vv. 7, 9)
- The psalmist focuses on God who is his shelter even when his enemies continue to pursue him but he believes that they would get defeated (vv. 7, 9-11) The present situation does not consume his mind, but God consumes his thoughts (vv. 9-11)

The thing that dominates the psalmist in his exile is not his home or comforts, but God:

1. I will see you (vs. 2)

2. I will witness your power and splendour (vs. 2)
