6. Of the three Persons of the Trinity, Who is largely the focus in the Old Testament?

Who is the main focus of the Gospels?

Which Person of the Triune Godhead is the main character of the book of Acts?
7. What is Christ’s response when the disciples ask Him in verse 6: “Lord, is it at this time that You are restoring the kingdom to Israel?”
8. According to Acts 1:8, from Whom does the power come from to be witnesses for Christ?
9. According to Galatians 5:16, how are we to activate the power of the indwelling Spirit that is within us as believers in Christ?
10. What is the geographic progression of the spread of the Gospel in the book of Acts according to verse 8?
